

Wanda is well-known in the arts industry as a speaker, singer, writer, and radio host. She has hosted the program LEEF for nearly 22 years on Radio Pulpit 657AM and Cape Pulpit 729AM. She was also a host on Radio Impact in Gauteng. She is the co-author of approximately 15 publications and the author of Wilderneswenke vir Vroue, a self-help book for the recovery from trauma, disappointment, and loss in women, which has recently been published.

She is a national and international speaker and artist. Previously, she was the presenter of the Afrikaans Hosanna TV program on SABC2, field presenter for the In Pas TV program on KykNet, and host of the Kyk Nuut program from NG Moreleta on Rhema TV. She has played lead roles in various theater productions at the State Theatre, including the musical "Gans Dans" directed by Jannie du Toit, "Houtkruis the musical", and others. She has also released 13 CDs. Many of these productions have taken her to England, France, Germany, Switzerland, Belgium, Dubai, and Namibia. In the Footsteps of Jesus was later also recorded as a TV production in Israel and made headlines nationwide. She was also the founder of WIX – Winners in Christ, with which she created various SABC productions and toured nationwide.

Awards: She won the ATKV Lier award for "Best Gospel Artist" two years in a row. Wanda was a finalist in the SAMA music awards and received the CBSA award as the best gospel female artist for her production "Ek sal wag." Wanda is the founder of the HeelVrou concept and offers these camps and workshops nationally and internationally with great success. She is currently working on a new book and continues to perform nationally in communities and corporately, where she shares

her testimony, insights, and ministry with a variety of audiences. She also offers various courses to empower radio broadcasters and courses for women on "Self-Realisation."
